## **Policy Process Summary**

- Periodically, each policy owner, or designee, should review applicable policies and determine if a revision is warranted. Also, KSU leaders should continually assess if a new policy is needed.
- When the policy owner, or designee, revises or drafts a policy document, the revisions are reviewed by the Director of Policy and, if applicable, Legal Affairs.
- For a new policy or if revision of an existing policy is determined to include a substantive change, the policy draft proceeds through the review process before posting on the Policy Portal.
- If revision of an existing policy is determined to include no substantive change (e.g., position title, office name, phone number, URL, etc.), the revised version is posted on the Policy Portal.

#### **New Business**

Hazing Policy – Breana Ware

- Policy revised to align with changes to Georgia Code.
- PPC members suggested two editorial changes.
- In response to a question, Breana stated the policy and disclosure applies to alumni.

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## Outdoor Amplified Sound Policy – Brian Garsh

- New policy codifies and updates existing regulations.
- The draft is consistent with KSU's Freedom of Expression Policy, including portions about time, place, and manner of expression.
- The policy does not apply to university-sponsored events, for which existing Department of Event and Venue Management rules account for time, place, and manner of expression.
- PPC members suggested clarification of exclusions and exceptions.
